THE ABOVE NAMED COMPLAINING WITNESS BEING DULY SWORN SAYS THAT THE ABOVE NAMED DEFENDANT(S) IN THE COUNTY OF MILWAUKEE, STATE OF WISCONSIN.

**COUNT 01: POSSESSION WITH INTENT TO DELIVER CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE - COCAINE (MORE THAN 40 GRAMS)**

Between December 19, 2006 and January 19, 2007, at 4673 North 67th Street, City of Milwaukee, did knowingly possess with intent to deliver more than 40 grams of cocaine, a controlled substance, contrary to Wisconsin Statute sections 961.16(2)(b)(1) and 961.41(1m)(cm)4.

**AS TO COUNT 01:**

Upon conviction of this charge, a Class C felony, the maximum possible penalty is a fine of not more than \$100,000 or imprisonment for not more than 40 years or both.

Upon conviction of this offense, the court shall suspend the defendant's operating privilege for not less than 6 months nor more than 5 years pursuant to section 961.50(1), Stats. If the court suspends the defendant's operating privileges the court shall impose a reinstatement assessment fee of \$60.00. If the defendant's driving privileges are already revoked or suspended, any revocation imposed must be served consecutively.

Complainant is a special agent with the Wisconsin Department of Justice Division of Criminal Investigations and bases this complaint upon his own investigation which reflect the following:

ON Tuesday, December 19, 2006 Complainant was working with a Confidential Informant who engaged in a controlled buy of suspected narcotics from the residence of the defendant. The controlled buy is a situation where the Confidential Informant works with an officer regarding the purchase of a controlled substance from a person at a known address. In this case, the complainant searched the Confidential Informant to make sure the Informant had no controlled substances or money on his person, and then the complainant gave the Informant money to go into a residence known to be occupied by the defendant. This residence was located at 4673 North 67<sup>th</sup> Street in the City and County of Milwaukee. The Informant entered this residence at approximately 5:35 p.m. on December 19, 2006 and exited the residence a short time later with a plastic shoe box containing one plastic bag containing approximately 125 grams of suspected cocaine. The Informant was then provided with \$3,000 in US currency by the complainant, and the Informant then presented this money to an associate of the defendant.

The Informant also indicated that he went into the residence of the defendant, and the defendant was present inside. The defendant directed the Informant to a baggie containing cocaine sitting on a table. The defendant then directed where and to whom the \$3,000 should be paid by the Confidential Informant and the Informant used funds from law enforcement in order to complete this transaction.

The suspected controlled substance was then transported to the State Crime Laboratory where it was tested and received a positive result for cocaine having a total weight of 122.13 grams.

On January 11, 2007, complainant again met with the Confidential Informant for another purchase of cocaine from the defendant's residence located at 4673 North 67<sup>th</sup> Street in the City and County of Milwaukee. At this time the Informant was again searched for any drugs or weapons or any other contraband before he was sent into the residence of the defendant. The Informant entered the residence at approximately 4:34 p.m. on January 11, 2007 and exited at approximately 4:37 p.m. and presented to complainant one clear baggie of a white substance suspected to be cocaine. Again complainant provided the Informant with \$3,000 of US currency and the Informant was observed traveling to a location to provide these funds to another individual to complete the transaction. With regard to this transaction the Informant indicated to the complainant that he observed the defendant, Dominique Robinson waiting for him inside of the residence at 4673 North 67<sup>th</sup> Street. He indicated that the defendant was looking outside of the front door as the Informant approached the residence. When the defendant let the Informant in the Informant could smell cocaine being cooked into cocaine base. The Informant observed two four and half ounce quantities of suspected cocaine on a table inside of the residence. The substance was given to the Informant by the defendant and subsequently tested by the Wisconsin State Crime Lab where a positive result was indicated for the presence of cocaine having a total weight of 123.98 grams.

On January 19, 2007, complainant and other law enforcement agencies searched the residence of the defendant located at 4673 North 67<sup>th</sup> Street. Inside the residence Officers located approximately 9 ounces of cocaine base and a digital scale. This substance was subsequently tested by the State Crime Lab where it received a positive result for the presence of cocaine base having a total weight of 252.58 grams.

On December 16m, 2008 at approximately 6 p.m. law enforcement officers arrested Dominique Robinson at the residence located at 4673 North 67<sup>th</sup> Street. Located on the defendant at the time of arrest was a cellular telephone with the phone number of 414-915-8528. This telephone number corresponds with the telephone number used by the Confidential Informant in the two drug transactions indicated in this complaint.

In a statement to the complainant after his arrest the defendant admitted that he stored cocaine inside of his residence for the purpose of distribution to others. The defendant also admitted to distributing cocaine on his own behalf to other individuals.




Based on his training and experience complainant is aware that the quantities of cocaine purchased through the Confidential Informant are quantities intended to be distributed to others and not for personal consumption.
